## PROHIBITED REPAIRS

Envelope:	The replacement of more than 50% of the fabric panels present at the time of the original manufacture, counted by the number of panels, irrespective of area. (Factory supplied pre-cut panels or pre-sewn assemblies must be used where more than 10% of the envelope fabric panels are to be replaced at any one time).
Burner & Fuel System:	The repair of any metal components or hose assemblies.
Fuel Cylinders:	Repair to the aluminium, steel or titanium shell of the cylinder or any of its thread bores.
Baskets:	Replacement of more than 20% of the total basket surface area.
Load Bearing Wires:	The repair of swaged flying cable assemblies or basket wires.
